Use the checklist below to see how your garden shapes up for nature!

a) Do you have any of these food features?

- Bird feeding station
- Nectar rich flowers
- Fruit trees or berry bearing shrubs
- Perennials left un-cut until spring
- Vegetable patch / container
- Herb garden

b) Do you have any of these shelter features?

- Dead wood / Log pile / Stone pile
- Climbing plants on wall/trellis (eg. Ivy, Honeysuckle, Clematis)
- Mixed native hedge (eg. Oak, Hazel, Hawthorn, Blackthorn)
- Mature trees
- Some lawn left to grow long
- Mini wild flower meadow
- Bird, bat or hedgehog box
- Insect hotel

c) Do you have any of these water features?

- Wildlife pond – no fish!
- Bog / permanently wet area
- Bucket pond
- Garden close to stream or water source
- Drought-resistant plants
- Bird bath

d) Do you have any of these management features?

- No use of pesticide & slug pellets
- Avoid chemical weed killers
- Compost bin, heap or wormery
- Rain butt to save water
- Use peat free compost
