

## **Data Coverage**

Information on sites and species is held and managed by the Surrey Biodiversity Information Centre on behalf of a wide range of partners. SBIC also has data sharing agreements with many of Surrey's specialist recording groups and our response will include this information where appropriate. We do however recommend that you also contact the following organisations who may hold information relevant to your enquiry.

### **Amphibians and Reptiles**
