

Training course requirements

Leader in Outdoor Learning (Level 2)

(Accredited by the Open College Network West Midlands)

- Participants should be over 18 years old and have some experience of delivering a curriculum to young people, for example teachers, teaching assistants, or other educators.
- All participants must be DBS checked.
- Attend the three days of theory and practice.
- Be able to plan and deliver at least three outdoor learning sessions.
- Complete a workbook of evidence.
- Course commitment approximately 70 hours.
- Option to attend a monthly mentoring session (these are not compulsory but highly recommended).

The course should take participants six months to complete, although some have handed all coursework in after a few months. It can take several months for the work to be marked and for the Examination board to validate and send the certificate to us.
