

Easy Bird Kite

What you need:

- A4 Paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- Stapler
- Hole Punch
- String (no more than 1m long)
- Colouring Pencils

How to:

- 1. Fold the A4 paper in half, along the long edge.
- 2. Fold down the top corners on one side, so they are about a third of the way along the length of the paper.
- 3. Staple the two corners folded together (picture examples below)
- 4. Add a tail and beak if you want to. You can make any shape you fancy!
- 5. Make a hole about halfway along the folded edge of the paper.
- 6. Thread your string through the hole and tie it off.
- 7. Decorate the kite! It could be a bird, a bat, or anything you want!
- 8. Take it outside and run with it!
