Coronavirus Volunteer Code of Conduct	
All volunteers who participate in Trust-led activities are required to follow the Code of Conduct:	
	Respect that some people may prefer to maintain 2m social distancing
	Wear a facemask if taking public transport or car sharing
	Volunteers will be asked to pre-book before attending a session
	Sanitise hands regularly throughout the day - bring your own alcohol-based sanitiser/hand wash if possible
	Tea kits will be available – or bring your own refreshments/cup etc if you would prefer
	Bring the work gloves you have been issued with. Ask if you need a new pair
	Hand tools, equipment & PPE will be cleaned prior to the session
	Support staff by following their safety guidelines
	Minimise sharing of vehicles, tools and equipment
	Do not attend if you, or someone you live with are displaying any of the symptoms of COVID-19, or have tested positive in the last 10 days <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A high temperature • A continuous cough • Shortness of breath • Headache • Congestion or runny nose • A loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste
